



# NaDEET Urban Sustainability Centre SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Using hands-on practical learning, our school programme challenge learners to think and live in a more sustainable way. The 3-day school programme is directly linked to the Namibian curriculum, allowing teachers to take their learners out of the traditional classroom while fulfilling the lesson plan.

## PARTICIPANTS

We welcome primary school learners. We recommend the grade levels 5 to 7. The recommended group size is 20-25 learners with 2 accompanying adults.

## PROGRAMME DURATION & TIMES

The Urban Sustainability Centre school programme is three days in length from Tuesday to Thursday.

### Daily Schedule

The daily programme is from 8am to 4pm.



### Opening Times

We are open for school programmes from February to end November, including school holidays.

Environmental Education is a cross-cutting theme in the Namibian school curriculum. The NaDEET Urban Centre programme will assist you in teaching core subjects together with the important environmental skills and attitudes that learners need to have to address our current and future problems.



## SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Our school programme engages learners with both the urban and natural environment. It gives them practical experience in living a sustainable lifestyle while promoting teamwork. Through exploring environmental problems, learners are challenged to develop local solutions.

The school programme focuses on four major areas:

- Energy
- Water
- Waste
- Biodiversity

A key output of the NaDEET Urban Centre programme is to build skills in addressing environmental problems through improved teamwork, cooperation and leadership.

All NaDEET activities are linked to the Namibian school curriculum. This includes most subjects such as English, Maths, Sciences and Life Skills. We encourage teachers to use the NaDEET Urban Sustainability Centre programme as a continuous assessment opportunity.
