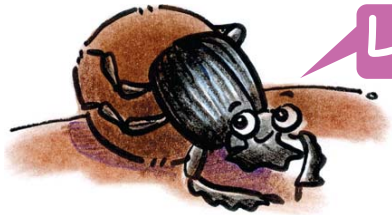

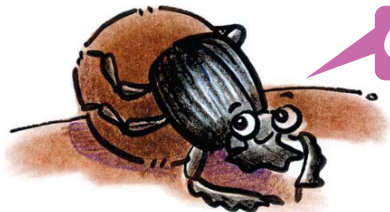

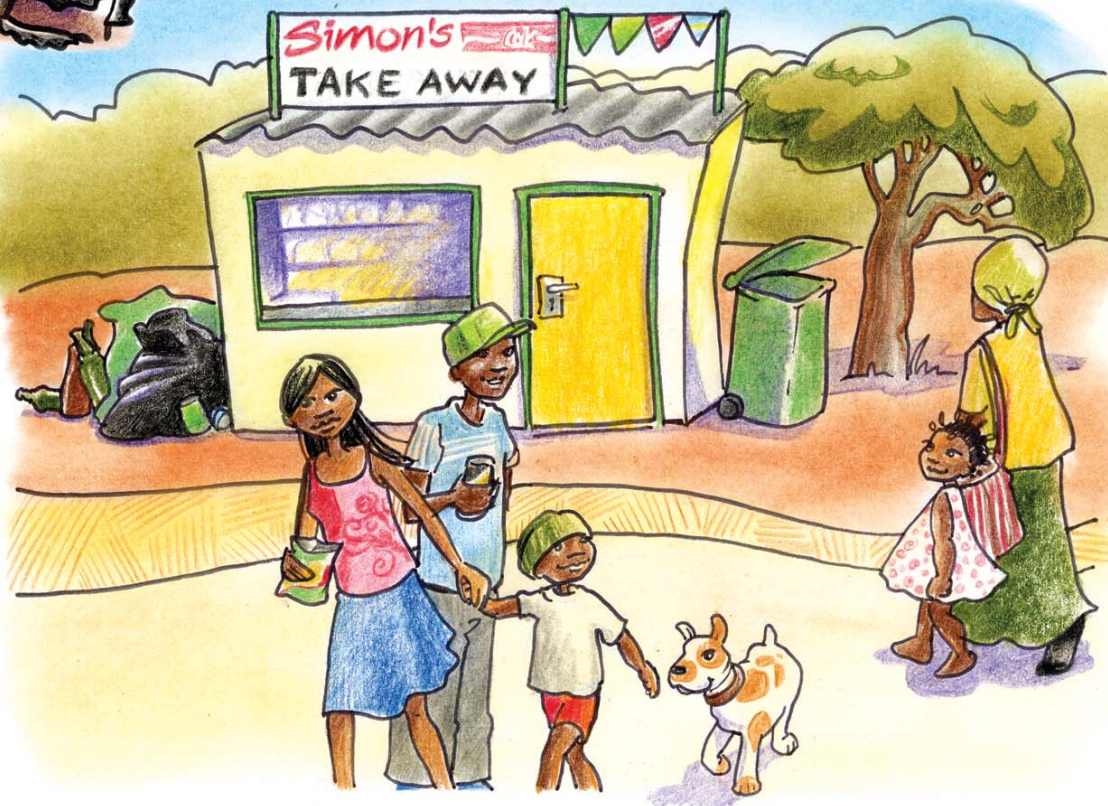

Find and circle the 6 differences in the two pictures:

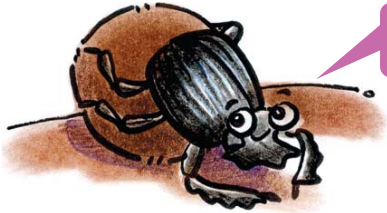


The larva makes a protection called a pupa where it slowly turns into an adult beetle.

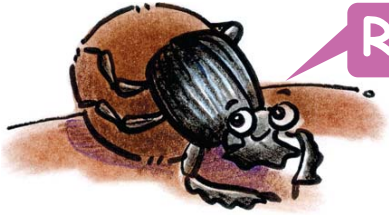


Shape sorting
