- Environmental Auditing



ENVIRONMENTAL AUDITING

"Measuring out Enviro Footprint" an environmental audit will take place with every programme.

The audit includes:

- *Water*
- *Energy*
- *Waste*



Participants use of these resources and production of rubbish is monitored throughout the programme. The results of the environmental audit are discussed with the group at the end of the programme.

SUSTAINABLE LEARNING

By living at NaDEET Centre, educator groups will be engaged in various sustainable living practices.

- *Daily preparation of solar cooked meals gives participants the opportunity to learn more about this carbon-free, cooking method.*
- *Environmental auditing makes participants aware of their impact on our natural resources. By understanding how much we use and produce, can we begin to reduce.*
- *Bucket showers using solar-heated water gives participants a nice warm shower, while using only 10 litres of water or less.*
