CLEANING UP AND ASSESSING THE DAMAGES

For the past 5 days NaDEET has been writing inventory lists and assessing the damage of last week's fire. On numerous occasions one of us as shouted out, "Oh, no— we also lost _____ in the fire". There are so many things that have been donated to NaDEET over the past few years from around the world that it is heartbreaking to have to write it on a inventory of burned items.



On Tuesday afternoon the assessor appointed by our insurance brokers visited the site to assess the damage. He will submit his report on Friday of this week. We hope that the insurance will properly cover the rebuilding of NaDEET's classroom and kitchen. Unfortunately it is already quite clear that our insurance policy will not cover the majority of the contents of the building that were lost. Only next week will we know our exact financial situation.

For the past two days NamibRand Nature Reserve and Tok Tokkie Trails have very kindly assisted us to clean up the site. They are currently dismantling the small section that survived the fire it now belongs to the insurance company.

We are also very grateful to the many emails and phone calls that have come in over the past few days with offers of support. NaDEET plans to re-open its doors with a temporary classroom and kitchen on the 10. July and to have the new building finished by the 1. August.
